### Judaism – Learning outcomes

	LOOK	LEARN	UNDERSTAND & RESPECT
<b>Year 1</b>	We care for the Earth & for each other	God is the creator; he cares for us; God created the world.	God is the creator of the world.
<b>Year 2</b>	There are special days.  Special places.	Saturday as God's special day – Shabbat. The family gather for the meal. Going to the synagogue to worship.	Shabbat, day of rest, worship & family.
<b>Year 3</b>	Commitment to belief.	Hannukah. Jews believe in one God; the Shema.	Tradition & symbols – Menorah. How the Jewish people express their love of God.
<b>Year 4</b>	We need guidance.	The Torah – the guidance God gives his people; God uses Moses to care for his people; Bar/Bat Mitzvah.	The importance of the Torah.
<b>Year 5</b>	Special seasons.	Pesach – God caring for his people; kosher food; family gathering; welcoming the stranger; special food.	The celebration of Pesach.
<b>Year 6</b>	Special seasons.	Yom Kippur – making a new start; forgiveness; how Jewish people prepare; opportunity to atone for sin.	The celebration of Yom Kippur.

### Sikhism – Learning outcomes

<b>Year 1</b>	Special place of worship.	Sikhs make people welcomes; they worship in a Gurdwara. Inside a Gurdwara.	Sikhs welcome everyone. Worship in the Gurdwara.
<b>Year 2</b>	Some symbols and their meanings.	The Khalsa and the 5 K's, the story of Khalsa; meaning of the symbols.	Outward sign demonstrate inward belief and commitment.

### Islam – Learning outcomes

<b>Year 3</b>	Special people.  Some aspects of worship	Who Muhammad was; stories of Muhammad – born in Mecca.  Friday is a special day of prayer; the call to prayer; inside the Mosque – decorations with patterns & texts but no pictures; men & women pray separately; holy book – the Qu’ran.	Muhammad is a special person for Muslims.  Worship in the Mosque.
<b>Year 4</b>	We remember important events.	Fasting and festivals; Ramadan, Eid-ul-Fitr, Eid-ul-Adha.	Muslims remember special events.

### Hinduism – Learning outcomes

	LOOK	LEARN	UNDERSTAND & RESPECT
<b>Year 5</b>	Places of worship and prayer.	Hindu temple (Mandir) worship. Meaning of symbols used and/or worn to pray. Symbols/clothes used for weddings.	How Hindu people worship.
<b>Year 6</b>	How messages are passed on.  We all celebrate.	Hindu holy books, Sanskrit; Vedas; poems telling stories of Rama and Krishna; children hear stories in the family.  Some of the Hindu stories – eg Krishna, Rama and Shiva.	Sacred writings are important.  Belief in one god, presented through different names and images.
